Round Wedge Table Mats, Mug Mats, and Ornaments

Materials:

Circular Mat - 18"

Two Fat 1/6 (13" \times 22") or asst. 6" \times 10" fabrics $\frac{1}{4}$ yd. Binding $\frac{5}{8}$ yd. (22" \times 22") backing

22" square batting

Use full size template - cut 12 wedges and trim 1" off narrow end before sewing to reduce bulk.

Optional: Simpli-EZ 30° Triangle Ruler is very helpful. Or use our template on the reverse side.

Mug Mats - 6"


 $2\frac{3}{4}$ " strips of assorted fabrics, backing and batting Use $3\frac{1}{2}$ " marking on wedge template and cut 12 wedges Narrow end will be $\frac{3}{4}$ " shorter then template, to allow for hole to turn.

Ornament - 4"

 $1\frac{3}{4}$ " strips of assorted fabrics, backing and backing Use $2\frac{1}{2}$ " marking on wedge template – cut 12 wedges Narrow end will be $\frac{3}{4}$ " shorter then template,

to allow for hole to turn.


Buttons and ribbon




Assembly:

- 1. Using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams, sew wedges together into two sets of six wedges, press all seams in same direction.
- 2. Sew the two sections together to make a circle and press seams in the same direction.
- 3. Backstitch at the narrow end, this will be the turning edge for the smaller mats.
- 4. For Table Mat...layer the wedge unit, batting, and backing together.
- 5. Quilt as desired.
- 6. Appliqué circle to center to cover opening.
- 7. The outside edge will be irregular, trim to make a circle. **Tip:** Use a piece of string and place in the center of mat, attach a pencil to one end, and go around the outside edge to mark your circle to be 18" - trim.
- 8. For binding, cut $2\frac{1}{2}$ wide bias strips, join together to make 60" and bind around the mat.







Ideas for Table Mats: Make mats in school colors, birthday colors... any holiday or celebration. Great for hostess and teacher gifts.

For Mug Mat and Ornament:

Layer batting, backing right-side-up, and pieced wedge section right-side-down; stitch together on outside edge with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam; turn right-side-out through open circle; press; appliqué circle to center to cover opening. For the ornaments embellish with buttons, beads, stitchery...let your imagination go. Add ribbon for hanger.
